**A Note About the Prelude:** Johann Pachelbel (1653-1706) was an acclaimed Baroque composer, organist, and teacher who brought the south German organ tradition to its peak. He composed a large body of sacred and secular music, and influenced greatly the work of Johann Sebastian Bach, whose brother Johann Christoph Bach was his pupil. Today Pachelbel is best known for his *Canon in D*. ***Preludium in D Minor*** begins with the theme in the pedals, which is then played and imitated on two manuals (keyboards for the hands). Contrasting scalar and chordal passages lead to a restatement of the theme in the finale.
