**A NOTE ABOUT THE PRELUDE:**

Charles-Marie Widor (1844-1937) was a brilliant French composer, organist and teacher who served the Church of Saint Sulpice in Paris for 67 years, the most prominent position for a French organist. Widor wrote a total of ten symphonies for the organ. They are daunting compositions, transferring all of the power and complexity of an orchestra to the organ. *Toccata*, the finale of Widor's *Organ Symphony No. 5* written in 1887, is one of the most famous pieces ever composed for organ. *Toccata* (from Italian *toccare*, "to touch") features fast-moving, lightly fingered virtuosic passages or sections.
