A Note About the Anthem:

The Sanctuary Choir anthem is an arrangement of *How Firm a Foundation*. According to the text, God's direction for our lives is found in a "firm foundation," the written Word. These hymn verses personalize promises from His Word: "*Fear not I am with thee, My grace is sufficient for thee, I will never leave or forsake thee.*"

The authorship of this hymn text has always been a mystery to hymnologists. The unknown author simply signed "K". *How Firm a Foundation* was first included in the collection "A Selection of Hymns" compiled by Dr. John Rippon in 1787. Dr. Rippon was the pastor of Carter's Lane Baptist Church in London, England, and was one of the most popular and influential ministers of his time.
