A Note About the Music: The Prelude, Offertory and Postlude were composed by the English organist Samuel Wesley (1766-1837) who was son of Charles, the hymn writer and nephew of John, the founder of Methodism. Wesley, deeply influenced by Bach, composed in the seventeenth and eighteenth century styles most familiar to him since the English tradition lacked an established repertoire of hymns. Characteristics of Wesley's compositions found in today's selections include the use of dotted rhythms, trills and imitation between the voices (fugue).

The music to the closing hymn, *The Church's One Foundation*, was composed in 1864 by Samuel Wesley's son, Samuel Sebastian Wesley (1810-1876), who was named for his father's hero, Johann Sebastian Bach.
