### **Children's Choirs/WASP Schedule**

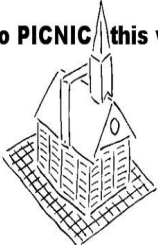

On Thursday, October 2, at 7:30 pm, a spectacular rededication ceremony will be held at Wesleyan College featuring a pipe organ concert performance by Peter Richard Conte. Recently redesigned and expanded through a million dollar renovation project, the 1925 organ and its nearly 5,000 pipes is the largest musical instrument in central Georgia. Conte is the Grand Court Organist of the world-famous Wanamaker organ at Macy's Department Store in Philadelphia, home of the world's largest playing organ. He performs extensively throughout the United States and Canada. The concert is free and open to the public. The Sanctuary Choir will attend. Buses depart at 6:15pm.
